Austin, TX, July 1, 2007: CPS Healthcare, Inc. developed the first-ever bi-directional medical image sharing capability, leveraging the FHIE (Federal Health Information Exchange) Plus BHIE (Bi-directional Health Information Exchange) Enhancements infrastructure. CPS Healthcare is now providing on-going operations and maintenance support of all FHIE Applications and Systems components for the Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) and the Department of Defense (DoD). Through this system, healthcare professionals are provided with timely and complete information that is vital to the care given to veterans, active duty military personnel, and their dependents.

The FHIE Plus BHIE Enhanced system provides the capability to exchange patient medical records between health information systems operated by the Veterans Health Administration (VHA) and the DoD Military Health System (MHS), and is a critical element of timely and complete healthcare information delivery. Recognizing that it is designated a Mission Essential System, it is imperative to ensure system integrity in support of the continuity of care that VA and DoD clinicians have relied on for the past six years.
